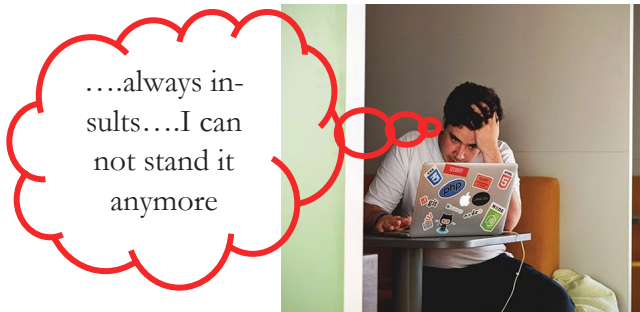

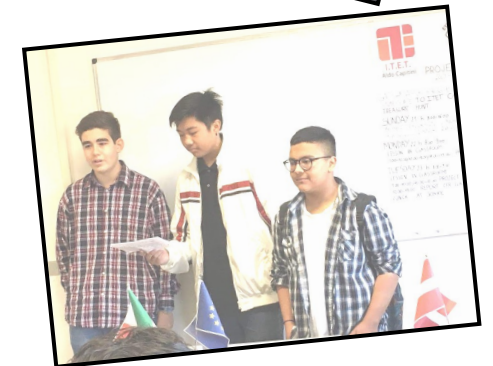
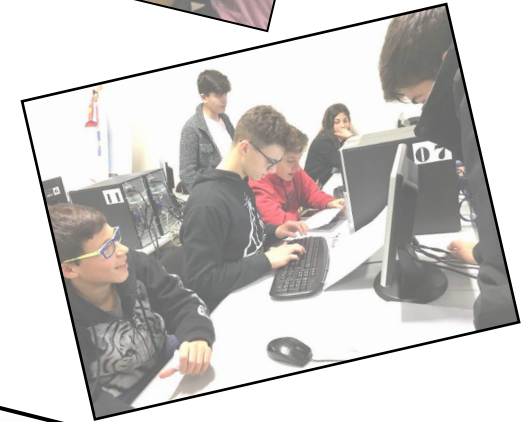


Cyberbullying
